

Resuming the Class 60 theme, in March and April DC Rail Freight (Devon & Cornwall Railways) have been working aggregate trains for parent Cappagh through Oxford Banbury Road terminal at Parkway. Empties have been recorded working to Willesden (as with 60 028 seen in the editor's photo above at Hinksey Yard) and Machen Quarry. ** From the 15 May timetable change, GWR 800 units cease to operate terminating services to Bedwyn, through trains from Paddington being cut back to Newbury. ** Electrostar 387 301, regularly formed into Paddington–Didcot locals, has GWR logos on its c2c livery, although also retaining Trenitalia branding.



1 May saw the 150th anniversary of the Buckfastleigh, Totnes & South Devon Railway. The editor was present at its centenary, as his snapshot indicates.
