




#### **ADRIAN SHOOTER**

We regret to report the death of Adrian Shooter on 13 December aged 74. Trained as a mechanical engineer, his early years on BR were involved with multiple unit maintenance before he moved across to more general management as area manager at St Pancras, running Red Star Parcels, and in charge of the Chiltern shadow franchise which he had the unusual experience of selling to himself as MD of Chiltern Railways, a key factor in winning the deal being his guarantee to provide the first new rolling stock for a privatised train operating company, the Class 168 DMUs. Takeovers saw Adrian as chair of DB Regio UK; he was also a founder of Vivarail. A memorial service should have taken place on Saturday at the Fawley Hill Railway. Adrian is seen here on the footplate of his pet Himalayan Darjeeling locomotive on the Beeches Light Railway surrounding his Steeple Aston home.
