



The last CrossCountry HST to visit Oxford: The Pines Express, a Leeds-Swanage excursion on 26 September, passes through as an '802' leaves for Great Malvern. 43008 in InterCity livery is leading; '007 in original colours was on the other end. This marks the withdrawal of the last few sets retained by CrossCountry for North East/South West services.

What has turned up under the Botley Road Bridge at Oxford station is going to require closure of the road for a full two years rather than with a winter break in the reconstruction works. After this year, Network Rail will not want to see 'Oxfordshire' and 'bridge' in the same sentence for some time.
