



May 3 Last day of service on the Bridport branch, leaving Dorset (and Somerset) without any BR branch passenger services. May 5 The prototype HST (with Mk 3 trailers) entered revenue service on the Bristol to Paddington route.

LOCAL RAIL NEWS

It's big engine time on the **Chinnor & Princes Risborough Railway**: after hosting a class 50 during its April diesel gala, the line will have USATC S160 class 2-8-0 no. 6046 (from the Churnet Valley Railway) available for service from later this month to the end of the season.

Didcot Railway Centre is staging a **Rivals Reunited** event between 14 May and 1 June with *Flying Scotsman* visiting to mark the 50th anniversary of being joined by *Pendennis Castle* on display at the British Empire Exhibition. There will be static displays as well as steamings, but check the DRC website for just what's scheduled when and to make bookings. The GWS has been awarded preliminary funding from the National Lottery Heritage Fund to develop a detailed programme for restoration of the engine shed roof.



57 305 pauses at Oxford on the first of several light engine runs over East West Rail to Bletchley scheduled at the start of this month. Despite the remnants of Rail Operations Group livery, the loco now belongs to GB Railfreight.
